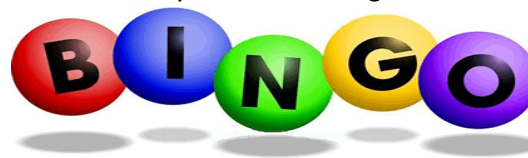
Red Nose Day
