### Summer Reading Challenge

The Summer Reading Challenge is a national scheme that all libraries in Cumbria have taken part in since 2001. The aim of the challenge is to develop a lifelong love of reading in children and prevent the 'summer reading dip'. This year's theme, Mischief Makers, ties in with the 80th anniversary of The Beano. It is free for children to join the challenge.

How the Challenge works

- Children sign up at their local library.
- Children borrow and read six books of their choice from the public library, collecting stickers along the way.
- Members of library staff and young volunteers are on hand to advise and run family-friendly activities.
- Children who complete the Challenge will receive a medal and certificate.

This year we want to appeal to children's competitive streak to get even more of them reading through the summer.
