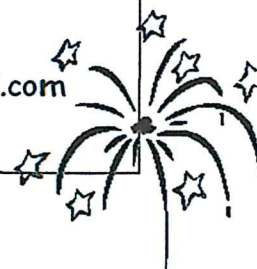


Please could you help?
